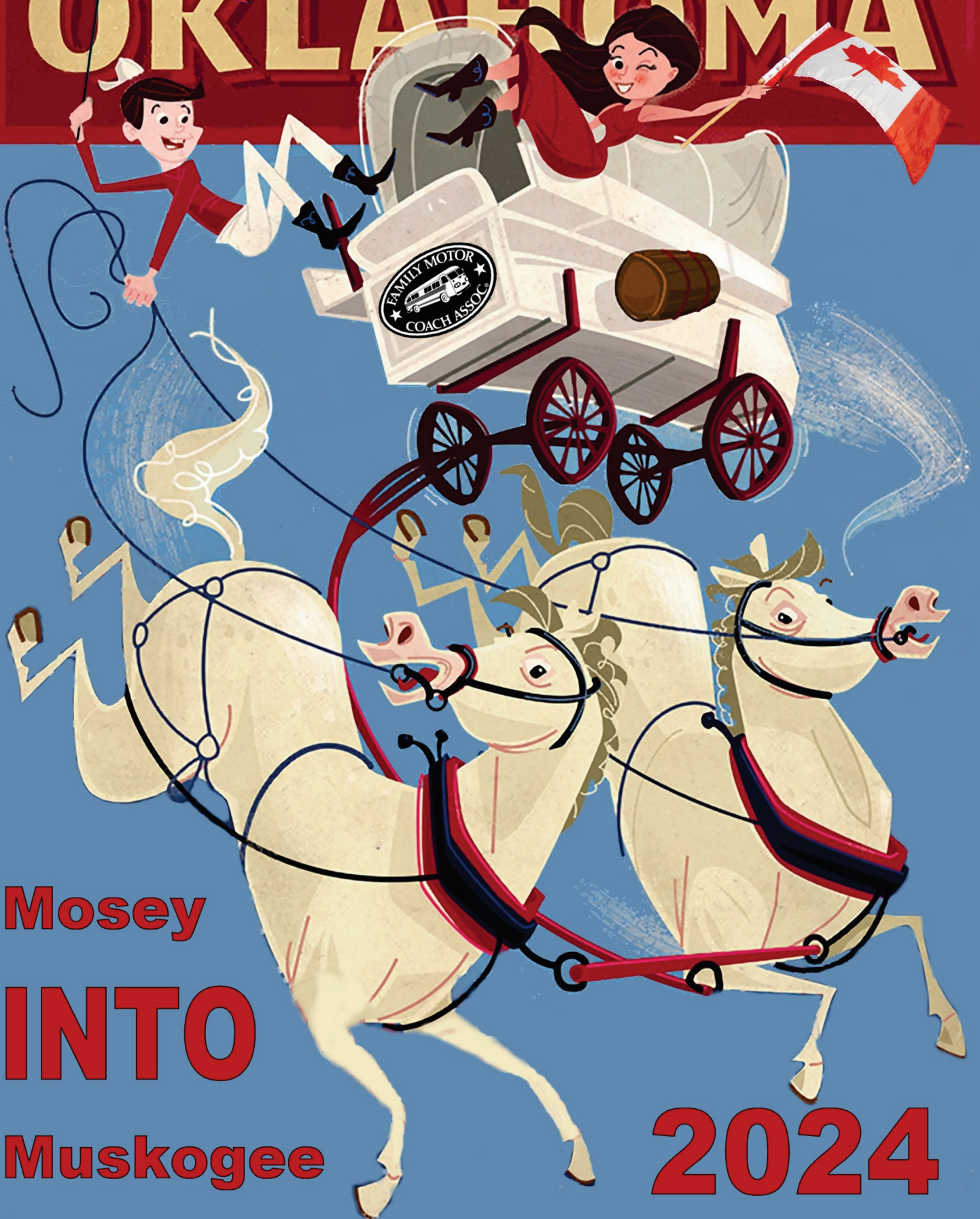

Important Information

Bicycles, Scooters & Motorized Vehicles: Bikes, scooters, and motorized vehicles are not allowed in buildings and must be parked away from building entrances and exits (except for scooters used due to disability). Riders must observe and obey all traffic controls and signs, established streets and lanes. Please respect pedestrians.

Cell Phones: As a courtesy to all participants, please turn off cell phones or put them on vibrate during all seminars and entertainment.

Credentials: All RVs and vehicles must display a placard with your name and phone # on it so that we can contact you in case of an emergency.

Fire Emergency: In case of a fire in or adjacent to your RV, immediately exit the vehicle. After you are out of the vehicle call 911. Then call the Security Coordinator at (518)461-8055 so that he can assist fire department personnel in arriving at your location. Also notify your neighbors, so that they can take precautions.

Medical Emergency: Call 911. Turn your flashers and outside lights on. Call the Security Coordinator at (518)461-8055.

Generators: Since all sites have electricity, the use of generators is not permitted except in the case of loss of shore power.

Carts: Please note that some of the carts operating on the grounds are privately owned or rented by individuals. These are not intended for use for general transportation of guests. If the operator offers you a ride in a private cart, please let them know that you appreciate their generosity.

Pets: We are glad that you brought your companions with you but unless they are a service animals they are not allowed in the buildings. They must be on leash at all times that they are outside your vehicle, and you must clean up after them.

HATBOX RV PARK GENERAL INFO AND RULES

No laundry facilities are available. Trash dumpsters are located on-site.

Speed Limit 10 mph. No parking in the grass.

Clear campsite of all litter and debris. Trash must be bagged and deposited into refuse containers provided.

Use of gas grills permitted; **campfires and open fires are not permitted.** Fireworks are prohibited.

Pets on leash and accompanied by owner at all times. Animal droppings should be cleaned up immediately. No aggressive dogs or barking nuisance will be allowed.

Parking is strictly at your own risk. The city of Muskogee is not responsible for your vehicle, its contents, or for personal injury or property damage sustained by you or your guests.

The use of loud, foul, or vulgar language and threatening or reckless behavior is not permitted. Police will be notified and grounds for immediate eviction. Damage or destruction of property will be paid for by the responsible party.

Respect the privacy of neighbors and no trespassing.

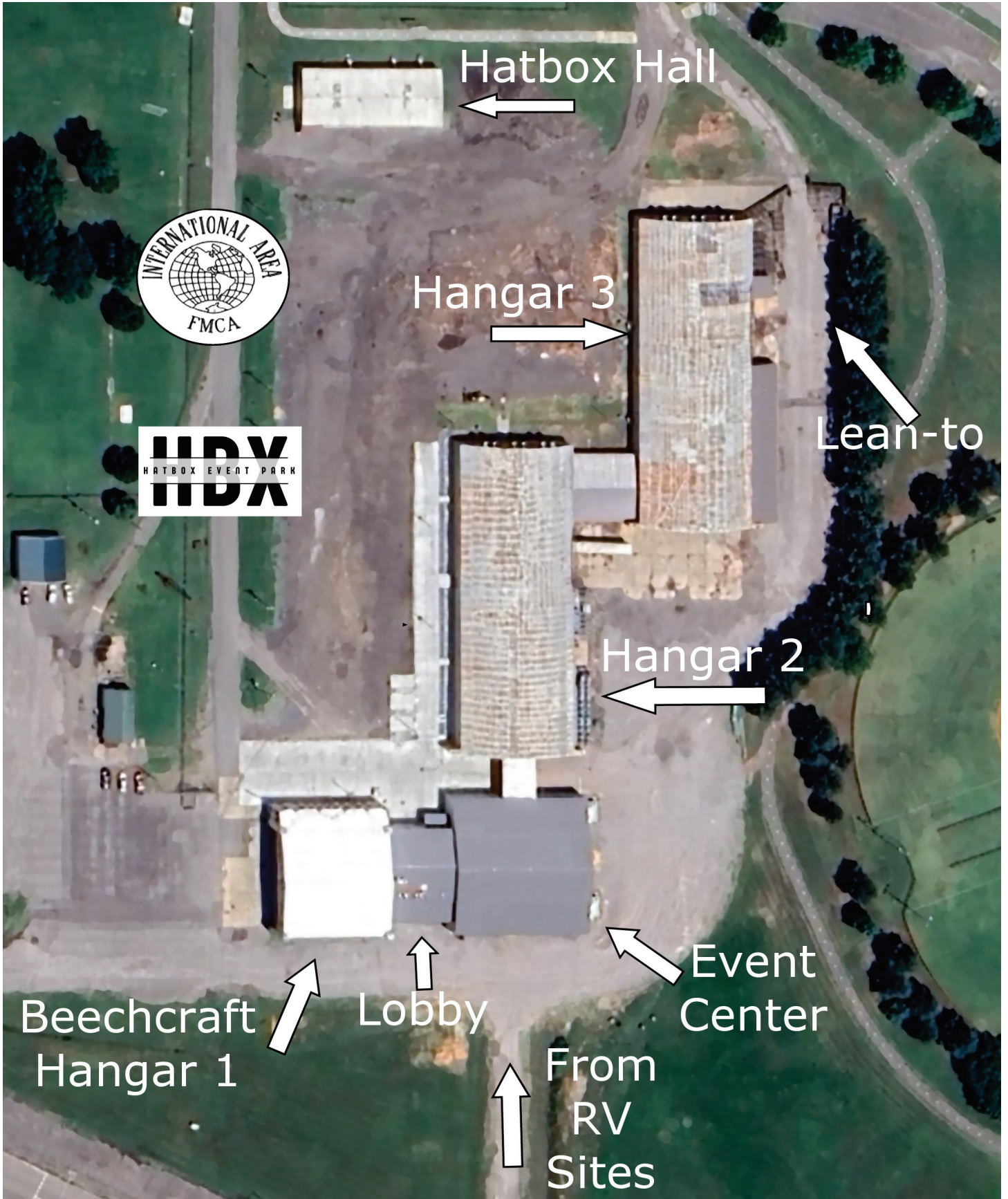

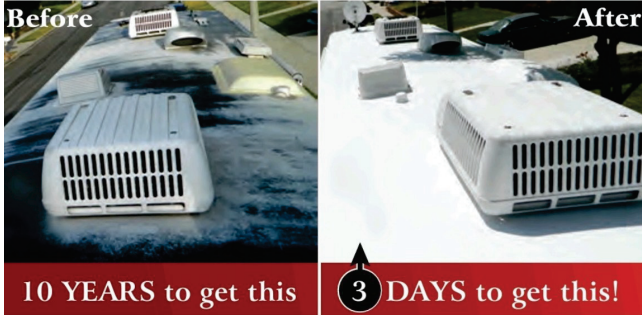
